KS2 lessons use simple, well-known stories to develop EBL skills. Simple stories allow pupils to manipulate their thinking about the characters and events in the story and to think about them from a variety of perspectives. This makes them ideal for developing EBL skills.


The front page of every EBL lesson sets out the EBL skills that will be developed in that lesson as well as the pupil activities in that lesson.

Every lesson finishes with a 5-minute CPD activity for teachers.

<i>Simple stories are one of the easiest way to deliver EBL skills</i>
Activities in this lesson include:
comparing the structure of a story (<i>Red Riding Hood</i>) to a newspaper article (a parody of <i>RRH</i>); reading and completing activities based on the parody. Activities also include answering higher and lower order questions.

EBL skills are best developed through simple stories

Cognitive overload occurs when our working memory is overwhelmed by too much information.

Simple stories allow pupils to think about the characters and events in these stories in more **complex** ways without any cognitive overload.



Red Riding Hood



Harry Potter

Pupils can think about the characters and plots in a simple story from a variety of perspectives without any cognitive overload.

Thinking about the characters and plots in a more complex story from a variety of perspectives can lead to cognition overload.

As well as covering genres in the traditional way, many EBL lessons also provide an alternative version of some traditional stories. This allows pupils to think about that story from a fresh perspective, for example:

Goldilocks Trashes Cottage

The First Little Pig is Arrested

Cinderella Gets on the Prince's Nerves

Beans for Cows and not a Bitcoin in sight

A Menace in the Woods

Cinderella Shows her Nasty Side

There IS a menace in the woods but it's NOT me!
Just saying.

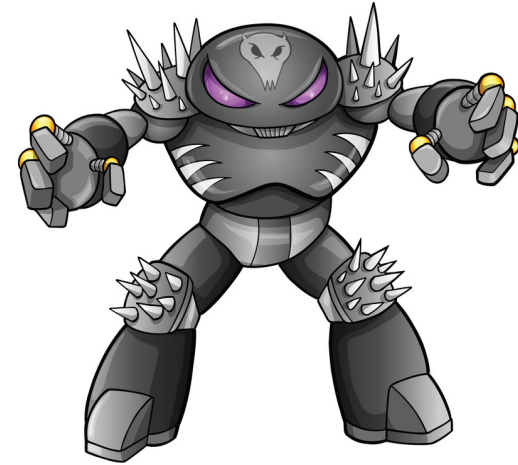

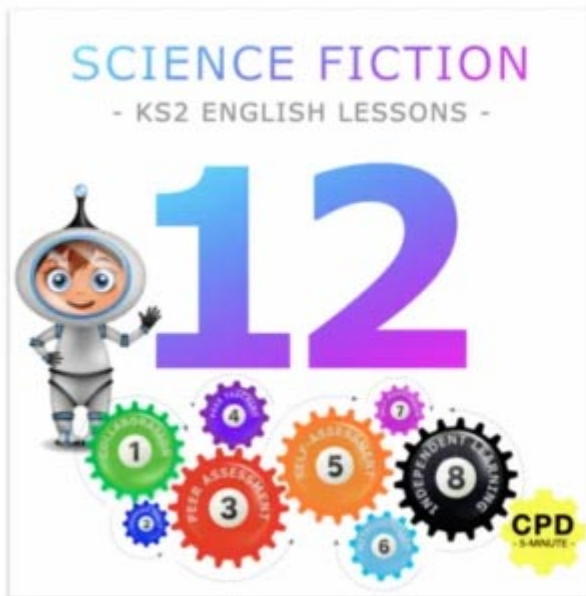

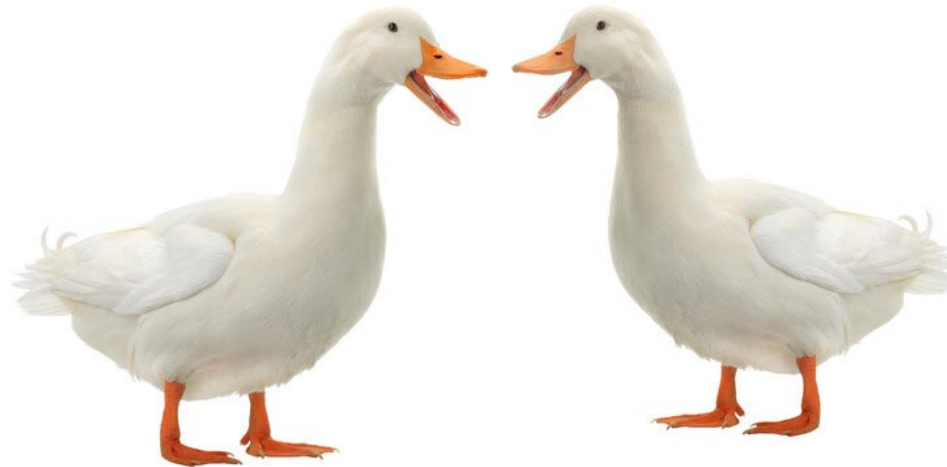
